SHOULD I AUDITION FOR THE ADDAMS FAMILY?

Volunteering with The Mackay Musical Comedy Players as both a performer and assisting with off-stage jobs is a great way to meet people, make friends, and experience all aspects of the theatre.

We are committed to securing performers and participants in the production who will be engaged and always committed and actively demonstrate their dedication to the production. Performers who will succeed in this production will demonstrate only the highest contribution to joining a team who will endeavour to make this experience memorable as a quality production for both the company and the region.

The following IMPORTANT INFORMATION will assist you to determine your ability to commit to the requirements of production **before** auditioning.

1. Attendance Expectations

a. REHEARSALS

- Rehearsal attendance is **compulsory** whenever called.
- A rehearsal schedule will be provided early in the rehearsal process and if you are going to be unavailable for any of those rehearsals due to **one-off commitments** such as weddings etc., then the Producers must be notified **in advance**. **Regularly scheduled activities e.g. work, sports practice, dance lessons, school band and music commitments etc** are not considered as one-off commitments.
- If you accept a role, you are entering into a commitment and there are no excuses for non-attendance. A commitment is made by every performer to attend all rehearsals, performances, and bump-in/out. This ensures a smooth-running show, and that fun is had by all. The directing team have decided that after three (3) absences from rehearsals (FOR ANY REASON), your role may be replaced, and you may be asked to leave the show. MMCP's COVID plan states that if you are suffering flu-like symptoms or have been asked



to isolate etc, then you must stay away from rehearsals. If your absence is due to the above plan or any other illness, and you attend the full rehearsal via ZOOM, this will not count as an absence.

- Rehearsals will commence on Sunday 22 Jan 2023, and this will be an all of cast rehearsal. All cast should be prepared to have their program photo taken, organise membership, discuss costume requirements and have a short Biography ready for submission. At this rehearsal, it is hoped that we will have the first outline of attendance requirements for characters.
- All cast will not necessarily be required at every rehearsal.
- Rehearsals are held on EVERY Wednesday afternoon/evening and Sunday afternoon up until Performance dates. **Sunday rehearsals on Labour Day weekend will be moved to Monday.** NOTE: Longer Sunday rehearsals may be scheduled when needed.
- **Rehearsals will continue over the April school holidays for principals only.**
- **Some PRINCIPAL rehearsals may be held with the Band on another evening closer to show dates.**
- Video and promotional photo shoots will be part of the dates on the rehearsal schedule and you may be required for these.
- Only cast and crew are to attend rehearsals. The rehearsal venues for MMCP have limited space for people to wait for their friends/partners that are part of the cast. Volunteers attending rehearsals must be pre-approved by the producers.

PLEASE DON'T CONSIDER AUDITIONING IF YOU CAN'T MEET THESE REQUIREMENTS.

2. Financial Expectations

a. MEMBERSHIP

Cast will be required to become financial members of MMCP. Invoices will be distributed after the first rehearsal and payment of **\$60** needs to be made **within the first 3 weeks of rehearsal.**

b. PERSONAL EXPENSES

These may include, but not be limited, to SHOES and UNDERGARMENTS e.g. your own pair of shoes with a heel (females) or dress shoes or boots (males) and/or other specific footwear, specific under garments in flesh/bone or grey colour etc. as well as socks, stockings or tights. Shoes may have to be colour changed. Second-hand shoes can often be bought from dancewear shops and painted the required colour. Details of shoe and undergarment requirements will be advised as soon as possible.



3. Off-stage Preparation Expectations

Please be aware that by accepting a role in this production, you are committing to helping in off-stage activities. As members, all cast (or a family member/friend as representative) will be expected to **participate actively in the off-stage preparations for this show.** This may include attending working bees at The Shed on Lamb Street on Saturdays to help with set construction, painting, costuming, publicity events, cooking BBQs, etc. There will also be tasks that can be completed at home. A range of skill levels will be required – there will most certainly be jobs that everyone can perform. More detailed information will be available at the auditions and throughout rehearsals. 4. Brief History

MMCP was founded in 1965 and staged its first production *The Boyfriend* that same year. From this humble beginning MMCP have staged numerous musicals over the years such as *Jesus Christ Superstar*, *Les Misérables*, *Singin' In The Rain*, *Grease*, *Hairspray*, *Legally Blonde*, *Mary Poppins*, *Wicked*, *The Wizard of Oz*, *Mamma Mia* and *Shrek* (to name a few). MMCP built its permanent residence on Lamb Street in 1978 and plans to continue its fine tradition of producing quality music theatre for many years to come.

5. Synopsis

THE ADDAMS FAMILY features an original story, and it's every father's nightmare. Wednesday Addams, the ultimate princess of darkness, has grown up and fallen in love with a sweet, smart young man from a respectable family – a man her parents have never met. If that weren't upsetting enough, Wednesday confides in her father and begs him not to tell her mother. Now, Gomez Addams must do something he's never done before -- keep a secret from his beloved wife, Morticia. Everything will change for the whole family on the fateful night they host a dinner for Wednesday's 'normal' boyfriend and his parents.

Hundreds of years ago, the Addams family ancestors came from the old country and settled on a plot of land in what is now New York's Central Park. This was, of course, long before it was a park, when it was still wilderness. The family flourished for many generations, and eventually, a huge house was built where a great Spanish oak, the Addams Family Tree, had been planted to protect the ancestral graves from such annoyances as sunlight and tourists.

Gomez, Morticia, Fester, Grandma, Wednesday, Pugsley and Lurch have gathered in the family graveyard, to celebrate life and death in a yearly ritual to connect with their past and ensure their future. They seem at peace, not just with each other and their dead ancestors, too - who emerge from their graves on this night each year to join in this celebration of continuity. But, at the end of the ritual, Fester blocks the ancestors' return to their graves. The unchanging Addams family values are about to be tested.

Fester enlists their help to set things right, just in case a new family secret goes terribly wrong. What's the secret? Wednesday Addams has grown up and found love. So, what's the problem? The young man, Lucas Beineke, is from Ohio, and his parents are coming to dinner to meet the family. Two different worlds are about to collide. Gomez and Morticia are understandably leery. Wednesday is their baby, even if she is eighteen. Their doubts bloom into actual terror when they eavesdrop on Wednesday, who, during her afternoon playdate with Pugsley, refuses to torture her brother. Like any parents faced with a child in terrible trouble, Gomez and Morticia wonder, "Where did we go wrong?"

Wednesday begs her parents not to cancel the dinner and exhorts the entire family to act as 'normal' as possible when Lucas and his parents arrive. While, lost somewhere in Central Park, young Lucas asks his parents to resist any judgments and all catastrophic conflicts, so both families can enjoy one normal night.



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Pugsley, having witnessed Wednesday and Lucas making out, worries that he's lost his best friend to her new, disgustingly sunny disposition. Plotting to break up the happy couple, Pugsley steals a volatile potion from Grandma's private stash - Acremonium - one swig of which is guaranteed to bring out the dark side in anyone who drinks it. After what is likely a less-than-normal meal, Wednesday quiets the table for Lucas' surprise announcement. But Gomez reminds Wednesday that, before anything else happens, it's time for the traditional Addams family game, "Full Disclosure". Gomez uses his Disclosure to try, again, to calm Morticia. Fester announces that he's in the throes of a most unlikely love - with the moon.

When it's Wednesday's turn, Pugsley seizes his chance! He secretly pours the Acremonium potion in the chalice and passes it to his sister. But his plan to awaken the dark side in Wednesday goes horribly wrong when Alice, coughing, intercepts the chalice and downs the potion instead. A whole new Alice, very dark and uninhibited, is born. Wednesday blurts out the news: "Lucas and I are getting married!" Chaos engulfs both families like a tidal wave, and Fester, urges the Family Ancestors to work some magic - whipping up a sudden, terrible storm and trapping the Beineke's with the Addams family for the night.

While the storm rages, Wednesday packs a bag, but Lucas has no appetite for running away and getting married without his parents' blessing. Wednesday, furious at everything it means to be normal, leaves alone. One more of Gomez' foot-in-mouth episodes prompts Morticia to throw him out of her boudoir. Her world is changing and she's not ready, and her only comfort is knowing that death is waiting for her, just around the corner. But it is very cold comfort indeed.

In the guest room, Alice, under the influence of the darkness potion, can no longer rhyme. Neither can she tolerate her husband's cynical attacks on Lucas and love. She packs him off with a pillow and blanket to sleep somewhere else, as the storm inside her heart, and outside in the park, rumbles to a conclusion. Once the rains have stopped, Fester heads outside for a couple of hours of moon-bathing, realizing -- after observing the three couples fighting -- the sheer luck of being in a long-distance relationship, with the distant silver orb in the sky that smiles down on him from the heavens. Sitting under the family tree, contemplating the twists and turns of this most unusual night, Gomez stops Wednesday on her way out of the park. He realizes the thing he was most resistant to -- his baby girl's growing up -- is inevitable, and proper. He sees that she's a young woman in love. And that makes him happy. And a tiny bit sad.

With her father's blessing, Wednesday offers Lucas one test to prove that he's The One. The test involves her skills with a crossbow, an apple, and Lucas standing with said apple on his head in front of the family tree. The boy is afraid of death, but even more afraid of losing Wednesday. He chooses the possibility of death over the certainty of loss -- and wins. Far below, in the grotto, Gomez and Mal, two displaced husbands, realize they have more in common that they would have dared imagine only a few hours earlier. While Mal is with Gomez, Lurch ushers Alice down to the grotto. She's a woman on a mission; she's going to lay down the law; changes must be made is the marriage is to survive.

Morticia packs a bag and is ready to leave. But the ancestors' spirits have led Gomez to find her. The other warring couples, Wednesday and Lucas, Alice and Mal, have made their peace. Now Gomez woos his wife, as he first did one night many years before, with the promise to "laugh and cry and dance until the very gods weep with envy." The mournful strains of a bandoneon waft up on the breeze, entwining with the tempting wail of a violin -- and a tango begins -- the Tango de Amor, the quintessence of Eros, the dance that makes men weep and women cry out in the night. The irresistible expression of love between husband and wife. And Morticia cannot resist.

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With all three couples reunited, Fester is emboldened to make his move, and launches himself to the moon. Landing safely, his face appears -- the man in the moon -- and love having emphatically triumphed in heaven and on earth, the gate to the family crypt swings open, allowing the spirits of the ancestors to rest for another year. It's been a night of darkness. Everything's changed. And the new, extended family understands: The unknown may be frightening, the darkness overwhelming, but if we don't run from it, we may see our mysterious, miraculous lives finally illuminated. If we move toward the darkness, we might find love and acceptance. For when it is dark enough, we can see the stars.

7. Audition Day/s Procedures

a. WHAT TO BRING

b. WHAT TO WEAR

- Please wear covered in shoes or dance shoes – NO bare feet, thongs or sandals
- Please wear appropriate clothes for movement; pants – not skirts and no loose tops.

c. AUDITION DAY PROCESS

- Auditions will be closed, and Visitors (Parents/Partners/Teachers/Friends) will have to wait outside while the audition is in process as we wish to give you/your child, the best opportunity to perform without distraction.
- Please arrive at least 15 minutes before your audition time for all Auditions. This allows time to calm your nerves, familiarise yourself with the surroundings and for us to ensure that you have arrived and are ready for your slot.
- Please allow at least another 15 minutes after your slot in case we require more time with you.
- You will be assigned an auditionee number and be asked to wait in the holding area.
- A panel of the creative team will conduct the auditions. Please be aware that other individuals including assistants and an accompanist may be present at different stages.
- We aim to provide a supportive environment during the process, with several MMCP committee members, who are not part of the Directing Team, on hand to help with questions or difficulties.

8. Roles Available

a. WHAT ROLES ARE AVAILABLE

- All the roles in *THE ADDAMS FAMILY* are open, (as are all roles in MMCP shows) and we encourage everyone if they are interested in a role to audition.
- All cast members for *THE ADDAMS FAMILY* will be required to audition.



- *THE ADDAMS FAMILY* is a singing & dancing production, that requires strong singer/actors and strong dancer/singers who can maintain characterisation.
- American accents are required for all characters.
- Brief character descriptions, vocal ranges, age ranges and dance requirements are listed on the next pages.

b. MINIMUM AGE REQUIREMENTS

PRINCIPAL ROLES	Auditionees must be a minimum of turning 18 years of age or over in 2023 (i.e. born in 2005 or prior); with an ability to look older, as all parts are adult roles.
PUGSLEY	Auditionees must be a minimum of turning 10 years of age or over in 2023 (i.e. born in 2013 or prior); with an ability to look younger, as part is a child role.
ENSEMBLE ROLES & PIT SINGERS	Auditionees must be a minimum of turning 15 years of age or over in 2023 (i.e. born in 2008 or prior); with an ability to look older, as all parts are adult roles.

9. Audition Preparation for ALL Roles

- Collect the set sheet music for the relevant role/s from Dusk Mackay in Canelands Shopping Centre, Mangrove Road and prepare by listening to the US Tour cast recording on youTube (<https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=qo1gAJokgrw&list=PLN20oJoJil0RdrbEA6CW0AxXssFu-AYGu>) to familiarise yourself with the show version we are using.
- Refer to the following pages for more details.
- As you get to know the show and the music, please pay attention to the characters' vocal ranges and required skill sets. Just because you like a role doesn't mean you are suited for it, and you want to have the strongest audition possible.

10. Callbacks

- If you are successful in the first round of Principal & Featured Role Auditions, you **must** be available to attend the CALLBACKS on Saturday, 14 January from 1:30pm – 4:00pm.
- **If you are not available for Callbacks, you must understand that it may not be possible to consider you for a Principal Role in the show.**
- Do not be discouraged if you don't receive a Callback, as not all roles may be called back.
- Callbacks will take the form of a brief audition workshop with auditionees performing their song, and then reading from the script for the characters for which they are being considered. Some characters may be asked to dance/perform taught movement.
- This session will allow the directing team to see how you take direction, work with others and learn new material, under a supportive environment free from the stress of nerves.
- Please come prepared to have fun and support your fellow auditionees! (*Any additional dialogue required will be provided on the day*).

The cast will be announced on Facebook following the conclusion of the Callbacks, after we have finalised our casting decisions.
